The county would kick in half the cost. The cost for a sign and the sticks would be \$250.00. Motion by Dianne and second by Jim to pursue this project.

Kathy will speak with Peter Alnes and Dave Poirer concerning cutting down a tree that is hanging over the dock area at the public access.
