New Business:

Last quarter minutes read. Motion to approve by Mary, second by Nancy.

Treasurer's report with a balance of \$4,774.93 as of April 1, 2023 and a \$5.00 dividend. Motion to approve report by Nancy, second by Mary.

Kathy stated that she is just overwhelmed with her work load and doesn't feel she can continue producing the spring and fall newsletter. After much discussion it was decided to scale the newsletter back to a much shorter version with upcoming information only. Kathy felt this would then be doable for her. After discussion concerning the yearly clean up at the public landing a motion was made by Dianne and seconded by Nancy that we discontinue this project at this time. We can go back to it in the future if we see that there is a need.

Kathy will contact Paul about making the online store available ASAP. Mary will contact the Bible Camp to see if and when they will be having fireworks this year.

Kathy had been to the Bruce Township Board meeting and they have requested to come to our annual meeting in August to offer information and field questions concerning the road and other issues. It was agreed that this would be a great idea.
